MOTION TO VACATE DEPOSITION DEADLINES**

Upon consideration of Defendants' consent motion to vacate deposition deadlines, and because good cause has been shown, it is, therefore, ORDERED that:

- Defendants' Motion is GRANTED;
- The deposition deadlines as set forth in the Court's July 31, 2018 Order, ECF No. 199, are VACATED; and
- The parties shall file a joint status report with a proposed amended schedule for all discovery deadlines, dispositive motions deadlines, and pre-trial deadlines within 21 days after the final resolution, including any appellate proceedings, of Plaintiffs' Motion to Compel, ECF No. 177, and Plaintiffs' Motion for Judicial Determination of Privilege, ECF No. 178.
