**PLAINTIFFS' CONSENT MOTION TO MODIFY THE SCHEDULE FOR  
SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEFING REGARDING REMANDED DISCOVERY  
PROCEEDINGS**

Plaintiffs respectfully submit this consent motion to request modification of the schedule by which the parties will provide supplemental briefing regarding discovery proceedings remanded to the United States Magistrate Judge following the Court's September 3, 2019 Memorandum Opinion (ECF 267) and Order (ECF 268). In support thereof, Plaintiffs state as follows:

1. On September 3, 2019, the Court issued a Memorandum Opinion (ECF 267) and Order (ECF 268), granting in part and denying in part Defendants' Motion for Reconsideration, Motion to Continue to Stay Compliance with the Magistrate Judge's Memorandum Opinion and Order, and Request for an Administrative Stay (ECF 257). The Court ordered that this case be remanded to the United States Magistrate Judge to conduct further discovery proceedings consistent with the Memorandum Opinion. ECF 268.

2. On September 18, 2019, the United States Magistrate Judge issued an Order directing the parties to provide supplemental briefing on the issues for remand consistent with

the Court's Opinion. ECF 271. Pursuant to that Order, the parties would submit simultaneous briefing limited to the issues for remand, with such briefing due within 14 days of the Order, that is, by October 2, 2019. *Id.*

3. To permit the parties to more fully address the issues on remand and avoid any inefficiency or inconsistency that could arise from simultaneous briefing, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the supplemental briefing schedule be modified as follows:

- a. Plaintiffs to file an opening brief no later than October 7, 2019;
- b. Defendants to file a brief in response no later than October 25, 2019; and
- c. Plaintiffs to file a reply brief no later than November 6, 2019.

4. Plaintiffs' counsel have conferred with Defendants' counsel regarding this Motion, and Defendants consent to the proposed modification to the briefing schedule.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Court enter an order modifying the supplemental briefing schedule for the remanded proceedings as set forth in Paragraph 3 above.
