UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ENTRY OF ORDER

Defendants respectfully file this motion for an order authorizing the release of certain materials that are a part of the administrative record. Specifically, those materials include complaints that individuals have submitted to the United States Department of Health and Human Services Office for Civil Rights. Although Defendants have identified and redacted personally identifiable information in those complaints, they request out of an abundance of caution that the Court enter an order authorizing the release of these materials as part of the administrative record, including any information that may be covered by the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552a. *See* 5 U.S.C. § 552a(b)(11) (permitting disclosure of information protected by the Privacy Act pursuant to a court order).

Defendants respectfully ask that the Court enter the requested order by July 22, 2019, the date by which Defendants are to produce the administrative record to Plaintiffs. Unless and until the Court enters the requested order, Defendants will be able to produce to Plaintiff only the portions of the record that do not contain potentially Privacy Act-covered information.
