8 Plaintiffs Aiden Stockman, Nicolas Talbott, Tamasyn Reeves, Jaquice Tate,

9 John Does 1-2, Jane Doe, Equality California (collectively, “Individual Plaintiffs”)

22 amended scheduling order and suspending the remaining deadlines set forth therein

25 Mandamus Petition in *Trump v. Karnoski*, Case No. 18-72159 (9th Cir.);

26 WHEREAS, on July 15, 2019, the Court entered an order approving the

27 Parties’ proposed amended schedule (ECF No. 162) (the “Amended Schedule”);
