JOINT MOTION FOR ENTRY OF DISPOSITIVE MOTION BRIEFING SCHEDULE

Pursuant to Local Rule 7.3(b), Plaintiffs Stacie Ray, Basil Argento, Jane Doe, and Ashley Breda (“Plaintiffs”), and Defendants Amy Acton, Karen Sorrell, and Judith Nagy (“Defendants”) (jointly with Plaintiffs, the “Parties”), by undersigned counsel, move the Court for an order approving the following jointly-proposed Dispositive Motion Briefing Schedule to govern the Parties’ anticipated cross-motions for summary judgment.

1. On March 29, 2018, Plaintiffs filed this action against Defendants under the First, Fifth, and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution. ECF No. 1.
2. On September 12, 2019, this Court denied Defendants’ Motion to Dismiss Plaintiffs’ claims for failure to state a claim.
3. Discovery closed on October 30, 2019.
4. The Parties have conferred and propose the following dispositive motions briefing schedule:
 - a. Plaintiffs and Defendants shall file their cross-motions for summary judgment not to exceed 20 pages, on or before January 16, 2020.

- b. Plaintiffs shall file their opposition to Defendants' motion for summary judgment and Defendants shall file their opposition to Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment not to exceed 20 pages, on or before February 13, 2020.
- c. Plaintiffs shall file their reply in support of Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment and Defendants shall file their reply in support of Defendants' motion for summary judgment not to exceed 20 pages, on or before February 27, 2020.

5. After conferring, the Parties believe the foregoing schedule will allow the Parties adequate time to present their respective positions to the Court.

WHEREFORE, the parties respectfully request that the Court enter the above schedule.
