PROCEEDINGS: ORDER FROM CHAMBERS

The court has completed its preliminary evaluation of plaintiff's motion for partial summary judgment and defendant's cross-motion for summary judgment.¹ A request for oral argument has been made, and that request is granted.

Plaintiff is represented by both local (Anchorage) and out-of-state (California and Georgia) counsel. Defendant is represented by an assistant attorney general officed in Juneau. Because the Alaska Legislature will soon be in session in Juneau, the court would prefer to hear oral argument in this case at Anchorage, but will defer to the preference of counsel for the parties in light of the fact that this case was filed at Juneau, Alaska.

Subject to the availability of the Juneau courtroom and hotel accommodations, the court is prepared to schedule oral argument (20 minutes per side) on January 14, 15, or 16, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. On or before **December 30, 2019**, counsel will please confer and advise the court as to their joint preference regarding location (Anchorage or Juneau) for oral argument and a date for oral argument.
