ORDER

On August 1, 2019, this civil action was stayed until further order of the Court pending the outcome of an appeal filed in a related action, Roe v. Spencer, Case No. 18-cv-1565. [Dkt. 241]. On March 3, 2020, the “the formal mandate” in that appeal was returned following affirmance of the Court’s preliminary injunction. [Roe, Case No. 18-cv-1565, Dkt. 253].

Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that this civil action be and is UNSTAYED.

Additionally, based on a telephone conference held on the record on March 5, 2020 with attorneys for all parties present, it is hereby

ORDERED that plaintiffs file their motion for summary judgment on all counts, which is not to exceed 70 pages, no later than May 4, 2020; that defendants file their combined brief in opposition and cross-motion for summary judgment on all counts, which is not to exceed 70 pages, no later than June 3, 2020; that plaintiffs file their combined brief in opposition and reply

brief, which is not to exceed 40 pages, no later than July 2, 2020; and that defendants file their reply brief, which is not to exceed 40 pages, no later than July 20, 2020.<sup>1</sup>

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel of record.
