ORDER

ORDERED that plaintiffs file their motion for summary judgment on all counts, which is not to exceed 70 pages, no later than May 4, 2020; that defendants file their combined brief in opposition and cross-motion for summary judgment on all counts, which is not to exceed 70 pages, no later than June 3, 2020; that plaintiffs file their combined brief in opposition and reply brief, which is not to exceed 40 pages, no later than July 2, 2020; and that defendants file their reply brief, which is not to exceed 40 pages, no later than July 20, 2020;¹ and it is further

ORDERED that defendants' Unopposed Motion for Extension of Page Limits, and Memorandum in Support Thereof [Dkt. 243] be and is DENIED AS MOOT.
