5 consecutively beginning with 1; defendant's exhibits shall be numbered
6 consecutively beginning with the next number series not used by plaintiff.

7 Duplicate documents shall not be listed twice: once a party has
8 identified an exhibit in the pretrial order, any party may use it. Each set of exhibits
9 shall be submitted in individual file folders with appropriately numbered tabs.
