**ORDER REQUIRING
DEFENDANTS TO PROVIDE
IMMEIDATE COVID-19
TESTING AND TRASNPOR
OF PLAINTIFF**

Consistent with the discussions between the Court and counsel for the parties during the July 1, 2020 telephonic status conference held in this matter, the Court hereby orders as follows:

- 1) Defendants must immediately test Plaintiff for COVID-19 and take any efforts necessary to expedite the receipt of her test results.
- 2) If Plaintiff's COVID-19 test result is negative for the presence of the

virus, Defendants must arrange for the timely transport of Plaintiff to a facility that will enable her to receive gender confirmation surgery as ordered by this Court and as previously scheduled by Defendants.
