The Court has reviewed Plaintiffs' Motion to Seal Plaintiffs' Combined Reply in Support of Plaintiffs' Motions for Summary Judgment and Opposition to Defendants' Motions for Summary Judgment and Exhibits, and the public memorandum filed in support thereof. Upon consideration of Plaintiffs' motion and supporting memorandum, the Court hereby FINDS:

1. That public notice of the request to seal and a reasonable opportunity to challenge the request has been given;
2. That the targeted and limited sealing sought by Plaintiffs is the least drastic alternative available; and
3. That the common law and First Amendment presumptions in favor of public access to records are outweighed for the reasons set forth in Plaintiffs' memorandum.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, it is hereby

ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion to Seal is GRANTED.
