ORDER

The Court will hold an in-person hearing on Louisville's motion to dismiss and Nelson's preliminary injunction motion on August 7, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. The Court's website details the current rules for in-person hearings, which include social distancing requirements and capacity limits.

1. The parties' deadline for filing a joint notice answering the following questions is

July 31, 2020:

- a. Does any party object to an in-person hearing? Nelson's lawyers may still participate by video if they are unable to travel.
- b. How many lawyers will appear in person for Nelson and Louisville?
- c. Is there anything else the Court needs to know in planning for the hearing? For example, a lawyer or a party may be in a high-risk category. High-risk individuals don't need to disclose what makes them high risk.
