**JOINT STATUS REPORT**

Plaintiff and Defendants, by and through their attorneys, provide the following status report as directed in the District Court's July 6, 2020 Order [Dkt. 95]:

1. On May 31, 2019, the Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals granted Defendants' petition for permission to appeal [App. No. 19-8012; Dkt. 4].
2. On June 17, 2019, the appeal was transferred to the Appellate Court's miscellaneous docket and assigned Appellate Case No. 19-2142.
3. On July 29, 2019, Defendants filed their appellate opening brief. [App. No. 19-2142; Dkt. 4].
4. On August 28, 2019, Plaintiff filed his response brief [*Id.*, Dkt. 10].
5. On September 18, 2019, Defendants filed their reply brief. [*Id.*, Dkt. 15].
6. On November 5, 2019, the Appellate Court heard oral argument and the case was taken under advisement. [*Id.*, Dkt. 21].

7. On August 31, 2020, the Appellate Court affirmed the decision of the District Court denying dismissal of the disability claim, and reversed its decision dismissing the sexual orientation claim. [*Id.*, Dtk. 25].<sup>1</sup>

8. On October 5, 2020, following extension, Defendants filed a petition for re-hearing, *en banc*. [Dkt. 35].
