hi, I wanted to let you know that I have an interview for a job on Tuesday. Not sure if I am going to take it- still have lots of thinking to do. It pays well though and I would only have to work part time to pay my bills. I wouldn't start until October if I did take it. My brother is moving to WI in the next few weeks and I wanted to spend some time there before he left. I probably won't see them unless I go to WI for a visit which won't be anytime soon. It is about a 20 hour drive he said.

Also-

I interviewed with Matthew H from Lifesite news today and this is basically what I said. He did say he was going to look up the PKPA law b/c I really couldn't tell him alot about it- other than what I read in the brief you guys sent to the VA supreme court- where it was actually an addendum meant to supersede the PKPA- to protect the state's laws (hope I got it right):

I am standing for God's laws- that marriage is b/w one man and one woman.

I am also standing for VA marriage laws which state the same fact as God's laws- this time in 3 different ways- Doma, House Bill and VA constitutional marriage amendment.

This battle is not only about Isabella and me- it is about parent's rights *everywhere in the nation*. Janet is not a parent- Judge Cohen legislated from the bench that she was and because of his ruling the door has now been flung open for individuals to be able to claim "parental rights" over a child that is not biologically or by virtue of adoption their child.

If VA does not rule according to our laws- that VA does not have to enforce the Vermont court order which clearly violates our policy of marriage then states everywhere -regardless of their pro-family laws- will be forced to recognize gay marriage (the Attorney General of Michigan clearly stated that in his amicus brief to the Supreme Court of Virginia in 2007) and biological parents may lose custody of their biological children to ex partners who are in no way biologically connected and or adoptively connected to their biological child.

Isabella is a political hostage and is being used by the gay agenda to push their agenda of gay marriage. They say and have said in the past in regard to gay marriage that it will not hurt anyone. Well, they are wrong- a little 7 year old girl is being hurt- and they want to rip her away from her biological mom (me) and give her to a legal stranger- a woman who is in no way related and in no way permitted by Virginia law (because of our pro-family laws and our artificial insemination law) to even have visitation with her. 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I hope Karl is feeling better. Stomach issues are the worst. My first week here I was sick with stomach issues and barely ate - I lost 6 pounds. (I have IBS as a side effect of my fibromyalgia) Please let him know he is in my prayers.

If I write a thank you letter to your class (a short one) will you be able to read it to the class? I have been praying for that group as a whole and some individual faces which really stood out. Your class definitely brought about a different perspective for me- when I looked out on that class I saw hurting faces, sympathetic faces, indignant faces and then faces filled with awe that anything like this could be happening or has happened. Your class represented the gammet of thoughts that one could have regarding homosexuality. I just can't get some of their faces out of my mind- the lady who asked me that question at the end is one of them. That is neat that the lady came up and asked you that question. That makes 4 people that week who told me to write a book. Two other people asked if I could act and then went on to say that I would be on Life Time TV before this was all over! I can't act but you can :):)

I had to smile when I read your "as for learning something new" because last night I changed the introduction to chapter 2 and it included something to that effect. Rena, not many people know what my life was really like growing up. I also have not shared the pornography addiction with anyone. The people who do know are people who didn't think it was an addiction. I didn't think it was either until much later- after I left the homosexual lifestyle. It was just something I knew to do to get my mind off other things in life. I would like to get across the definition of addiction right off the get go in this book. I think people need to know what an addiction is, what it does to you and what it looks like.

I do have many stories- just not sure what to share and what is applicable for this book. No one person has heard all my stories- rather, I spread them out for security puposes- if someone is too put off with my past then I can easily go on and be friends with the next person b/c they don't know about that story and never will b/ c I won't share it again. I really don't know what else to write. I am already at 6 pages and it is very long and I have not even touched what happened in the hospital or covered what happened after Erin to Janet. What do you want me to do?

Do you want me to start writing from where I left off at this chapter? or do you want me to go on to another chapter and come back to chapter 4 once you edit it and cut it down and then add the part from leaving Kirk to meeting Janet.

Rena, I am not sure what to include and what not to include of my life when I write. I could probably include more of Sheila b/c she was the first woman I felt comfortable around. She accepted me for who I was. However, the danger in that is that we were both hurting. We had similar pasts which is something that the lesbian community is famous for. Where you look at the heterosexual community- it is varied but the lesbian community is virtually the same in their history of their pasts. When I was very involved in the homosexual community and working at NOVAM with kids with HIV and AIDS I did not once meet a woman who identified herself as a lesbian who wasn't wounded in her childhood. This may sound weird but that is what binds people together- hurt. Birds of a feather flock together.

Writing these chapters is hard b/c it brings to the surface lots of feelings. It also brings me back to the place of "I wish I had never gone down that path".

Also, I have not verbally or physically shared the complete events of my past. I am sure that when you read this you may wonder why you never heard some of the things before. I just don't think to put it in my testimony or in my testimony talks because I don't know if it will help or if it will hinder another Christian or even a non- believer.

More importantly though, writing it all down brings to mind that the process of turning to homosexuality is a lifelong process. I think of Dobson's book (I think it is his book) that says that to save our children from becoming homosexuals we must talk to them about those dangers when they are little. Otherwise, we have lost our children. Think of the homosexual community- they are doing the same thing- trying to train a child. They take a child as young as 5 and try to indoctrinate their ways so that when they grow older they themselves will be more tolerant and perhaps join their ranks. It works both ways. We as Christians need to train our children to stand for God's principles and not man. and one way to do that is how I am-fighting to raise my child without the influence of homosexuality.

It reminds me of how some rocks are formed. Rena, some rocks take years to form and it is only from the constant pressure of the elements that they form in the shape and composition that they are today. I was that rock. It took years of the water gushing over me and the sand grinding in my skin and the wind blistering my surface to form me into a homosexual.

Sorry it took me several days to respond. All four of us have been ridiculously sick. Jake missed 5 straight days of school. I missed Friday of last week and Tues - Fri. of this week. I have never missed more than one day in a row except when my kids were born! Shannon has even missed several days - an he's a guy! They go to work half dead! Faith has also missed 4 days off and on. It's some weird combo of massive sinus infections with chills and fever like the flu... we seem to be on the mend...I hope! :)

I read your letter several times. Each time I read it I had a different reaction - weird. Okay - so here are my thoughts:

- 1) Tammy believes that her message came from God. I'm sure she truly believes it and I would not tell her any differently (then again - I avoid conflict at all cost - you on the other hand... :))
- 2) Why would God care more about states cooperating that he would about protecting the sanctity of marriage? That makes no sense.
- 3) In the20end, your case may come down to "states giving courtesy to another state" as she says (aka the Federal Kidnapping Laws vs. VAs DOMA laws), but that seems to me like a civil take on the issues rather than a spiritual one.
- 4) If her message is truly from God, then why is God giving you the message from only one person?
- 5) Is she a psychiatrist? How does she know that your course of action would be any more detrimental to Izzy than giving up? I agree with the something worse - I'm guessing she is hinting at custody transfer and you going to jail - that could happen.

6) She is also working with some mis-information, I think. What does she consider "preparing Izzy for the visits" to be? Either she didn't know that you are preparing her and are preparing to give the visits or she doesn't think you are going about it the correct way.

7) My overall reaction to your synopsis is that she is coming from a civil point of view, not a spiritual one. I'm left wondering where God is in the middle of her statements...

I couldn't believe it but then to my amazement, Vic hauled the truck and trailer up the very same steep bad driveway. What is it with these men. I see Myron left you a note the other day.

What a loaded question. This has been on my mind. I read in a book something I wanted to share with you and it has to do with the question you asked me. "Finally, If you accept God's forgiveness by receiving His Son, you need to realize that although the Lord will not deliver you from the consequences of your actions, he will give you the strength and protection to make it through them." Maggie, counselor, Clean Sweep by Barry Minkow, Pg. 183 Yes, Izzy has to suffer from your sin and rebellion against God, as you are. David's family suffered for years for what he did. What is the principle in Ru? Your sin hurts those who follow you. I don't remember which one it is. Then there is principle 10. Surrender. I think the sooner you take responsibility for you sins and acceptance of the consequences of your sins the less stress it will be on Izzy. If you cut and run, then you will be asking others to harbor a fugitive for a decision you made while living in rebellion to God. Asking them to give up their families and freedom. I don't think that's fair of you (and I don't think you would intentionally do that, but not sure that you would have seen it that way.). I know you wanted to do right by Izzy and I think you have given her a great grounding in the word of God. Now, trust that the Lord will have his way and do his work in her and through her and through these circumstances. Maybe

Janet will get tired of hearing about God. And you know, visitation wasn't all that regular with Janet before. End the battle and you will probably have Izzy all to your self. Work with the mental disorder. :-)
I didn't want to offend you but You asked and I felt God was laying this on my heart. When you asked I felt it was God's open door. I love you Lisa and want the best for both of you, my friend.
Ps. maybe a letter of apology to Judge Cohen would be in order, if you feel you have done wrong to him. (he has shone you much mercy, and tolerance for your disobedience).
