This case has been rescheduled for argument by video conference at **9:00 a.m. (Eastern Time) on Thursday, November 19, 2020** before a three-judge panel of the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals. You must be available for argument from **8:30 a.m. through 12:30 p.m.**, even if your argument is not first on the Court's docket. In addition, please note the following:

- Approximately one week prior to the argument date, you will be provided specific video conference information;
- The time allotted for oral argument remains limited to 25 minutes for the Plaintiff, 15 minutes for the Defendants, and 10 minutes for the Intervenors;
- You may learn the names of the judges sitting on the panel by checking the Court's calendar when it is posted on the Sixth Circuit's website at [www.ca6.uscourts.gov](http://www.ca6.uscourts.gov) two weeks prior to argument.

**If you are the attorney who will present argument in this case, download the Argument Acknowledgment form from the website and file it electronically with the Clerk's office by November 2, 2020. If you have already filed this form, please file a new form due to change in argument platform (from in-person argument to video argument).**

Counsel is strongly discouraged from seeking continuances of oral argument as they are granted only in exceptional circumstances. If counsel is seeking a continuance or waiver of oral argument, a motion should be filed as soon as possible. Please note that the filing of a motion for a continuance or to waive argument does not guarantee a ruling prior to the scheduled argument.
