LETTER TO COUNSEL:

Re: *Jennifer Eller v. Prince George's County Public Schools, et al.*
Civil Case No. TDC-18-3649

Dear Counsel:

Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's "Motion and Memorandum of Law in Support of an Extension of Time and Adjustment of Scope of the Remaining Discovery Period and Request for Hearing" (ECF No. 64). The motion will be granted in part and denied in part.

For good cause shown, the scheduling order is revised as follows:

June 16, 2020	Deadline for Defendants to complete their production in response to Plaintiff's May 8 and 12, 2020 letters
July 14, 2020	Close of discovery; submission of status report
July 21, 2020	Requests for admissions
September 1, 2020	Notice of intent to file dispositive pretrial motion

If there is good cause to do so, Defendants may file a motion to extend the June 16, 2020 deadline to complete their production in response to Plaintiff's May 8 and 12, 2020 letters.¹ Nonetheless, the Court observes that this deadline is nearly one month away. Defendants must make every effort to meet this deadline without seeking an extension, which will cause further delay in this case.

The Court declines to schedule a hearing in this matter. *See* Loc. R. 105.6.

¹ This Order will be entered before Defendants have had an opportunity to respond to the motion. Because the Defendants largely consent to Plaintiff's motion, and because the Court will give the Defendants an opportunity to move to modify the June 16, 2020 deadline if necessary, the Court does not believe a response is necessary.
