**INTERVENORS-APPELLEES' UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
FOR FILING PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REHEARING EN BANC**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 26(b) and Sixth Circuit Rule 26, Intervenors-Appellees Jane Doe and Sexuality and Gender Acceptance respectfully request an extension of twenty-eight days, to and including May 7, 2021, to file a petition for rehearing or rehearing en banc. In support of this motion, Intervenors-Appellees state as follows:

1. On March 26, 2021, this Court issued its opinion in the above-captioned matter.
2. Pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 40(a)(1), a petition for rehearing or rehearing en banc would be due on April 9, 2021.
3. Intervenors-appellees have good cause for seeking an extension of time. Intervenors-appellees' counsel currently faces multiple professional deadlines in April. In addition, counsel is currently working from home under Jenner & Block's work-from-home policy, and has substantial child care responsibilities in view of the partial or complete closures of

elementary schools and preschools in Washington, DC. For these reasons, it would be difficult for counsel to prepare the petition by the current deadline.

4. This request is the first request for an extension of time, and it is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay.
