**ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR
ANY BILL OF COSTS AND
MOTION FOR ATTORNEYS' FEES**

Before the Court is Plaintiffs and Defendants' Stipulation to Extend Time for any Bill of Costs and Motion for Attorneys' Fees. (Dkt. 80.) For the reasons stated therein, the Court finds good cause to grant the Stipulation.

ORDER

THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Stipulation (Dkt. 80) is **GRANTED** as follows:

1) Any motion for attorneys' fees or bill or costs based on activity after this Court's entry of final judgment on April 20, 2018 need not be filed any earlier than September 30, 2021, or 60 days after the completion of any litigation relating to HB 509, whichever is later.

2) The parties may request a further extension of time if necessary and upon a showing of good cause.

3) The Court makes no determination at this time as to whether either side is entitled to attorneys' fees and costs based on events or activities after the Court's entry of final judgment on April 20, 2018.
