**JOINT STATUS REPORT OF
JULY 29, 2021**

1 Pursuant to the Court’s June 15, 2021 Order, Dkt. 683, the parties submit the following
 2 update on the status of the litigation. The parties have reached an agreement in principle to fully
 3 resolve this litigation, including the allocation of all costs and fees between the parties. The
 4 parties are currently in the process of drafting the necessary documents to implement their
 5 agreement and stipulate to dismissal of this case. The parties do not believe that any impediment
 6 exists which would prevent the finalization of their agreement. Defendants have already
 7 obtained approval and authorization within the government for the agreement in principle.
 8 However, the parties require additional time to complete relevant documents. Accordingly, the
 9 parties jointly request an extension of the present stay until August 26, 2021. The parties
 10 anticipate that on or before that date, they will finalize their agreement and stipulate to dismissal
 11 of this case.
