

They also shared a beautifully emotional First Look, which is where our journey of their wedding day begins...









I got to show off Cherokee Park to Shelby and Brennen since they're new transplants from Nashville!


Big Rock Park is the perfect place for an engagement session because it's beautiful no matter the season.
