Good morning,

I spoke with Offender Diamond on 7/8/2020. She reported that she was unaware of the letter sent by her legal team and illuded to another PREA incident separate from the one involving UM Jackson. After probing Offender Diamond stated that multiple people had been sexually harassing her in the dorm. I attempted to complete a MH PREA evaluation but Diamond refused stating that she was "too emotional" to discuss this issue at the time. I noted her refusal on the evaluation form and rescheduled her for 7/10/2020. During our discussion, Offender Diamond discussed her medical concerns related to her genital binding and the complications that resulted from her actions. On 7/9/2020 I spoke with DWCT Betterson and was informed that no PREA evaluations could be completed for Diamond without a lawyer present. Betterson stated that he would contact legal and the evaluation is now pending. I documented that in a progress note and it is in her chart. If there is anything else you need or would like corrections to anything please let me know.

being transgender. Jackson called Ms. Diamond a man and proceeded to make inappropriate comments about her breasts and genitalia as well as her facial hair. Ms. Diamond told Mr.										
Jackson that those comments were harmful to her metal health, and Jackson walked away. A										
few days later, on June 18, 2020 GDC officials informed Ms. Diamond that she would be moved										
out of medical quarantine to another dormitory. This dormitory houses more than 100										
incarcerated people. When she entered the dormitory, Ms. Diamond noticed that several										
people were staring at her. Ms. Diamond eventually learned, through conversations with										
other incarcerated people in the dormitory, that Jackson had called a dormitory-wide meeting										
on June 17, the day before Ms. Diamond's move, during which Jackson told everyone gathered										
that a 'freak is about to walk in' and that they would just have to deal with it. Jackson

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Dear Dr. Jackson and Dr. Weinstein,

I just consulted with Dr. Fass who is not scheduled to work Tuesdays. Dr. Fass is requesting that Offender Ashley Diamond be admitted to ACU/CSU immediately as she disclosed a suicidal ideation plan in my office. In the last couple of weeks she has felt retaliated against, because of the lawsuit Security staff at coastal is following all of her movements with a camera. Her personal property was searched and she was written a DR for having pencils and the precipitating event to her current presentation was that her PREA rating was recently changed to reflect her as sexual aggressor and victim, which was done without cause. Therefore, in addition to requesting ACU/CSU for this acute crisis we are also requesting a change in prisons

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for her safety. Dr. Fass is insistent that we have tried several times to increase her level of care to ensure her safety and would like to continue with either a change in prison to another MH institution that she does not current lawsuit against or a change in mental health level which would also prompt a transfer. We believe that either route would be sufficient and beneficial for her
