ORDER

On May 9, 2022, plaintiffs filed a Joint Request for Clarification of Order, asking the Court to resolve an apparent discrepancy between the Memorandum Opinion and Order issued on April 6, 2022. [Dkt. No. 312]. The Memorandum Opinion stated that the Court would enjoin defendants from “categorically barring the worldwide deployment of asymptomatic HIV-positive service members with undetectable viral loads based on their HIV-positive status”; however, that language was not reflected in the Court’s Order. Because that omission was inadvertent, the Request for Clarification [Dkt. No. 312] is GRANTED, and it is hereby

ORDERED that the Court’s April 6, 2022, Order will be amended to include the omitted injunction.
