The Court shall hold oral arguments on Plaintiffs’ and Defendant’s motions to compel (Docs 121, 122) on **Wednesday, July 13, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. in Courtroom 6A at the Evo A. DeConcini U.S. Courthouse at 405 West Congress Street, Tucson, AZ 85701**. If any counsel is unable to appear in person, counsel shall file a motion to appear telephonically by no later than July 11, 2022.


Based on the Court’s review of the briefing, it appears that the parties are still engaging in negotiations as to at least some aspects of the discovery disputes; the Court strongly encourages the parties to continue to meet and confer prior to oral arguments to hopefully resolve some of the discovery disputes.

At oral argument, in addition to discussing the merits of the motions to compel, the parties should also be prepared to discuss at the outset of the hearing what additional negotiations have occurred (since receiving notice of this Order), if any outstanding discovery disputes have been resolved prior to the hearing (such that we no longer need to discuss the merits of the dispute at the hearing), and what primary discovery disputes still
