ORDER


The Magistrate Judge held a discovery dispute resolution conference on June 7, 2022, regarding issues raised in the parties' joint discovery dispute statement (Doc. No. 36). Based on counsel's representations made in the conference, the Court ORDERS as follows:

The Tennessee Attorney General's Office shall complete production of all written discovery responsive to all outstanding discovery requests by June 21, 2022. Because the parties have a large number of fact and expert witness depositions to be taken before August 10, 2022, for which they must prepare, the Court does not anticipate extending this deadline.

All other deadlines remain as set by the Court's prior orders (Doc. Nos. 22, 23, 33).

Counsel are reminded of their obligation to engage in good-faith case resolution efforts and to file a joint report of the status of those efforts by no later than 60 days before the October 7, 2022 dispositive motion deadline.

It is so ORDERED.
