MODIFIED SCHEDULING ORDER

*** **

Pursuant to the Status Conference on May 4, 2022, the parties have submitted a proposed Amended Scheduling Order (DE #36). The Court, having reviewed the proposed order, hereby AMENDS the Scheduling Order (DE #24) as follows:

1. That all fact discovery by the parties shall be completed on or before August 30, 2022. All expert discovery shall be completed by December 1, 2022.
2. That the Plaintiff shall designate all expert witnesses and make proper Civil Rule 26.02 Disclosure, along with providing any expert witness reports, by September 30, 2022.
3. That the Defendant shall designate all expert witnesses and make proper Civil Rule 26.02 Disclosures, along with providing any expert witness reports, by October 30, 2022.
4. That the parties shall have through July 30, 2022 to amend or join any additional parties.

5. All dispositive motions and/or motions in limine by no later than **January 6, 2023**, pursuant to Rule 7.01(e)(1)(2), **with response and reply time as per Local Rule 7.1(c)(1) and (2)**. No extensions of time may be granted by the United States Magistrate Judge or by agreement of the parties. Applications for extensions of time will be granted by the trial judge only upon good cause shown.

6. All deadlines established in the Court's Pretrial Order (DE #23) shall apply.

7. The **Pretrial Conference** before the trial Judge shall be conducted on **May 3, 2023 at 2:00 p.m.** at Lexington, Kentucky.

8. The **Jury Trial**, currently scheduled January 30, 2023, is CONTINUED to **May 30, 2023 at 1:00 p.m.** at Lexington, Kentucky; counsel and parties present at 12:30 p.m. Estimated length of trial is five (5) days.

9. Parties shall and are encouraged to attempt to mediate and/or utilize alternative dispute resolutions either through private service or through the United States District Court to resolve the matter if possible.

10. All remaining directives and aspects of the Scheduling Order (DE #24) remain in full force and effect.
