UNOPPOSED MOTION TO AMEND THE CAPTION**

First, the caption currently reads “Braidwood Management, Incorporated, on behalf of *themselves* and others similarly situated . . .” The movants respectfully ask the Court to change “themselves” to “itself,” because Braidwood is the sole representative of the certified class.

Second, the parties listed in the bottom side of the v. should be re-ordered as follows:

The five members of EEOC should be grouped together (the current caption has “the United States of America” in between Ms. Burrows and Ms. Dillon). In addition, Ms. Samuels should be listed second rather than third because she (and not Ms. Dhillon) is the current vice-chair.

The defendants-appellees/cross-appellants are unopposed to this motion.

The plaintiffs-appellants/cross-appellees respectfully ask the Court to amend the caption to read as follows:
