Dear Clerk:

Defendants-Appellees respectfully write to inform the Court of recent factual developments related to the mootness of Plaintiffs-Appellants' claims and, therefore, the Court's subject matter jurisdiction.

In their opening brief, filed in July 2021, Plaintiffs-Appellants stated that Alanna Smith and Ashley Nicoletti were rising seniors in the 2021-2022 school year, arguing that they were entitled to prospective declaratory and injunctive relief for that school year (**Pls' Statement of the Issues # 2; see also Doc. 40, pp. 26-39, 41; Doc. 104, pp. 13-21**), and retrospective declaratory and injunction relief to correct athletic records based on lost educational opportunities. (**Plaintiff's Statement of the Issues # 1; see also Doc. 40, pp. 20-25; Doc. 104, pp. 27-32**). Similar relief was not sought for Selena Soule and Chelsea Mitchell because both had already graduated and began their college track and field careers. (**See Doc. 40, p. 9 n. 2**).

In June, 2022, both Smith and Nicoletti joined Soule and Mitchell as high school graduates. (**JA133 ¶¶ 12-13; Doc. 40, p. 16**). Therefore, their claims for prospective relief are now moot. *E.g., Cook v. Colgate Univ.*, 992 F.2d 17, 19 (2d Cir. 1993). Additionally, publicly available authorities (**attached**) show that Smith and Nicoletti are both enrolled in universities and on the schools' respective Track and Field rosters for the 2022-2023 school year: Smith at the University of

Tennessee (Division I), and Nicoletti at Belmont Abbey College (Division II). Their claims based on lost educational opportunities are also moot.


