ORDER

On October 13, 2022, counsel for Defendant Clayton County advised the Court by email that “[t]he [P]arties mediated the above-referenced case on October 5, 2022, and the mediation was successful.” Defendant’s counsel further represented that the Parties “are working to finalize the settlement paperwork and will file a stipulation of dismissal when the settlement is complete.” Accordingly, the Court **DIRECTS** the Clerk to **ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSE** this case.¹ The Parties shall file a stipulation of dismissal upon finalization of the settlement documents. If settlement fails, the Parties should promptly move to reopen the case.

¹ The Court notes that administrative closure does not affect the rights of any Party. Any Party may move to reopen the case at any time.
