**PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR EXTENTION OF TIME TO FILE DISMISSAL  
PLEADINGS PURSUANT TO SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

COMES NOW Plaintiff, Mark Horton, by and through his attorneys, Mathis, Marifian & Richter, Ltd., and for his Complaint against the Defendant, Midwest Geriatric Management, LLC, states as follows:

1. On March 14, 2022, Plaintiff and Defendant jointly filed a Notice of Preliminary Settlement, advising the Court that they reached a preliminary settlement agreement and requesting that the Court stay all deadlines and pass the case for settlement for 60 days.
2. On March 15, 2022, the Court, having been advised of the parties’ settlement, denied all pending motions without prejudice and ordered counsel to file appropriate pleadings according to the settlement (e.g., stipulation for dismissal, voluntary dismissal, or consent judgment) within 60 days.
3. Since the entry of the March 15, 2022 order, counsel for the parties have negotiated the language of the parties’ written settlement agreement, and the parties’ counsel are currently scheduling appointments with their clients to review and execute the written agreement.
