Upon consideration of Plaintiff’s Motion for Preliminary Injunction, it is hereby:

ORDERED that Plaintiff’s Motion is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, until such time as a final judgment is entered in this matter, unless this Order is previously modified by this Court, Defendants shall be preliminarily enjoined in the following respects:

1. Defendants, and all of the officers, agents, servants, and employees of the Chico Unified School District (the “District”), shall be enjoined from socially transitioning¹ current students to a gender identity that is different from that reflected in the District’s official records without informing and obtaining consent from the students’ parents or guardians.

2. Defendants, and all of the officers, agents, servants, and employees of the District, shall be enjoined from failing to inform and obtain the consent from parents or guardians of all

¹ “Socially transitioning” refers to the active affirmation of a transgender identity and includes things like calling the student by a new name associated with their transgender identity, referring to the student by pronouns associated with their transgender identity, and allowing students to use restrooms and locker room facilities associated with their transgender identity.

1 current students who have previously been socially transitioned to a gender identity that is different
2 from that reflected in the District's official records and are still being treated as that gender identity
3 without informing and obtaining consent from the students' parents or guardians.

4 3. Defendants, and all of the officers, agents, servants, and employees of the District,
5 shall be enjoined from socially transitioning Ms. Regino's daughters, A.S. and C.S., to a gender
6 identity that is different from that reflected in the District's official records without informing and
7 obtaining consent from Ms. Regino.

8 4. Defendants, and all of the officers, agents, servants, and employees of the District,
9 shall be enjoined from failing to inform and obtain the consent from Ms. Regino if her daughters
10 A.S. and C.S. have previously been socially transitioned to a gender identity that is different from
11 that reflected in the District's official records and are still being treated as that gender identity
12 without informing and obtaining consent from Ms. Regino.

13 5. Ms. Regino shall not be required to post a bond.
