**JOINT STATUS REPORT**

1 As explained in prior joint status reports, the United States appealed to the U.S. Court of  
2 Appeals for the Fifth Circuit from the order and permanent injunction issued in *Texas v. United*  
3 *States*, No. 1:18-cv-00068, ECF Nos. 575, 576 (S.D. Tex. July 16, 2021).

4 On October 5, 2022, the Fifth Circuit issued an opinion affirming the judgment of the  
5 district court in part, and remanding to the district court for consideration of a final rule on the  
6 subject of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) that had been issued by the  
7 Department of Homeland Security during the appeal. *See Texas v. United States*, 50 F.4th 498  
8 (5th Cir. 2022). With respect to the partial stay that had been entered by the district court, the Fifth  
9 Circuit “preserve[d] the stay as to existing recipients.” *Id.* at 531. The Fifth Circuit has not yet  
10 issued its mandate.

11 Pursuant to this Court’s March 23, 2021 Order, ECF No. 319, the parties will file another  
12 joint status report on or before January 20, 2023, and then every 60 days thereafter.
