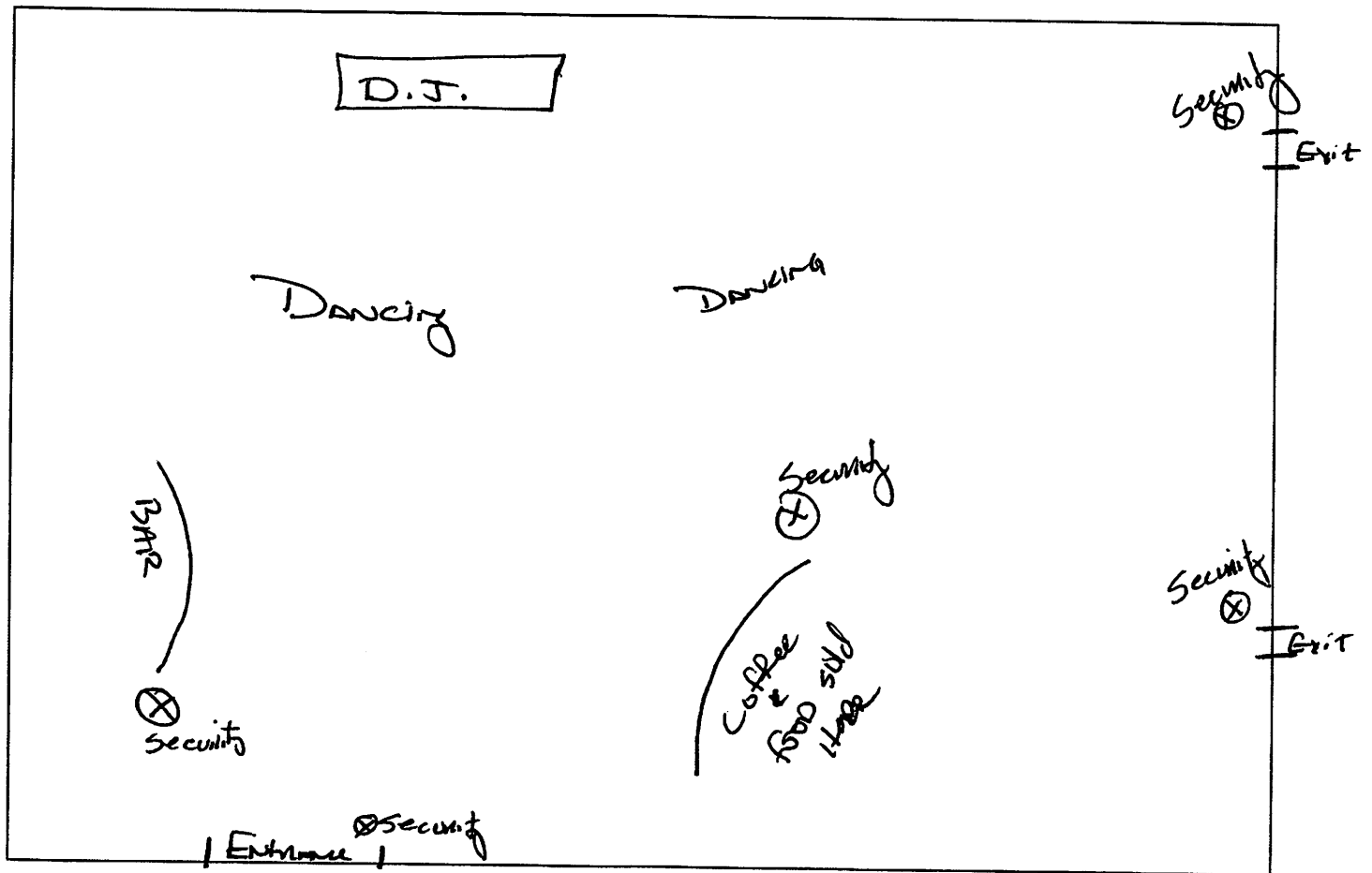

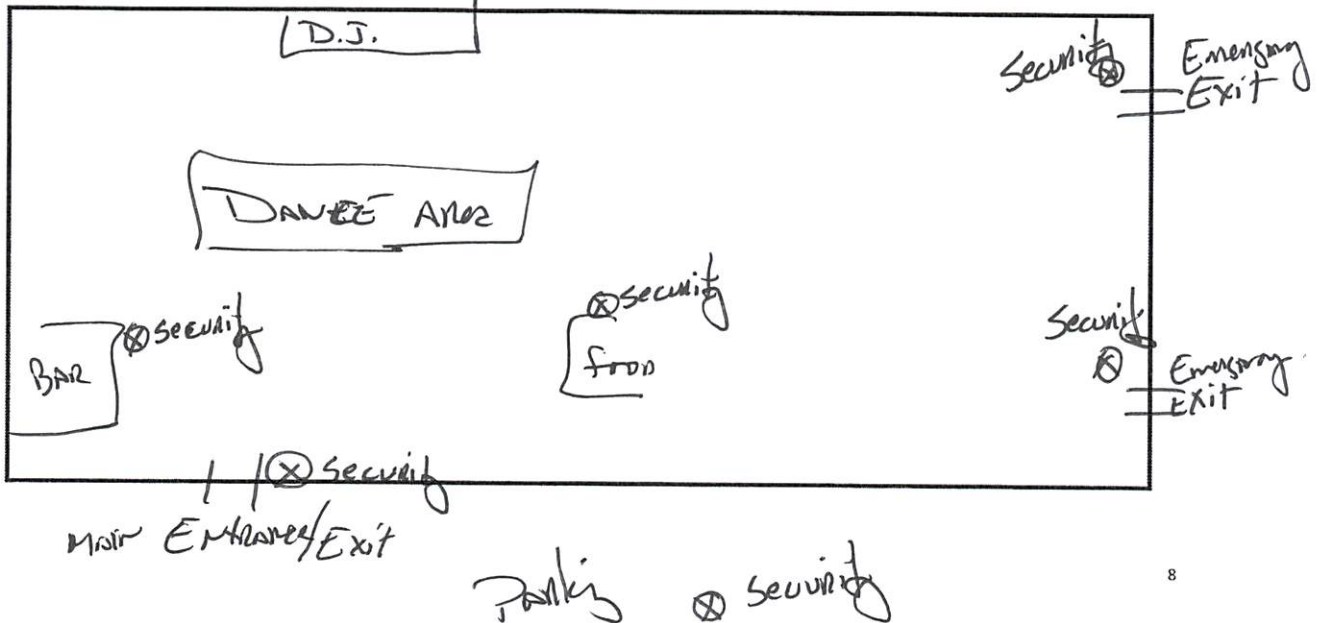



Now that we have your date confirmed, please send your **Special Event Permit Application** package to me so it can be reviewed by our committee.

As a concession for moving your event at the very last minute in 2019, the City agreed in 2020 to only charging you \$400 to reserve Town Square (instead of the standard \$150 per hour rate). According to my notes, all other concessions were satisfied in 2019 and do not carry over into 2020.

In addition to your \$150 Special Event Permit Fee, please also remember to collect a \$5 Sub-Licensing Fee from each of your vendors, so you can remit the total due via one check immediately after the event. Most event planners collect this fee as part of their vendor booth fee.

If you are planning to host a Family Picnic again this year, you'll need to get that location reserved and submit a separate **Special Event Permit Application** for it as well. The same goes for an After-Party event.

If you have questions about any of this, please let me know. 🙄

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties mutually agree as follows:

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **RECITALS.** The above recitals are hereby incorporated as part of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

This Agreement shall in no case be interpreted as giving permission to the use of private property or property outside of St. George City limits. User is required to obtain any requisite permits or approvals from any other governmental entity, organization or person for any property it intends to use as part of this event.**

3. **FEES.** User shall pay to City as a use fee for the Premises \$(Amount) for the term of the Agreement. User shall also pay \$0 as a security deposit which will be returned once the Premises have been inspected for damage and cleanliness and no problems are found. The full payment shall be paid at least thirty days before the use date or as agreed to by City. User shall pay for all equipment, staff time and any additional fees and costs which are listed in Exhibit "A". Any fees and costs invoiced to the User shall be due on the date stated. All late payments are subject to late fees and interest.
  4. **USE.** User may enter and remain on the Premises for the Activity as described in the Agreement. User is prohibited from using any portion of the Premises not authorized in the Agreement. No unapproved activities are permitted. User acknowledges that the Agreement is not for exclusive use and that City shall be able to use the Premises for other purposes including other events so long as the use does not infringe on User's right to use the Premises on the limited basis described herein. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as giving User any leasehold or other rights or interest in the Premises or facilities, nor any right to use the Premises or other property or facilities except for the uses expressly provided for in this Agreement. User may not use the Premises as a permanent or temporary residence. User must comply with the Premises policies and rules. Access to the Premises shall be provided by City.
  5. **APPROVAL.** As part of the approval process, User has provided City with a detailed description of the activities which will be allowed on the Premises which is described in Exhibit "A", the approximate total number of participants expected for the Activity, a detailed description of the security to be provided, a detailed description of the parking location and process, and any other information City staff, at their sole discretion, determine to be necessary in order to approve the Activity. If the number of participants exceeds the approximated number or the approved plan is not followed, City reserves the right to take any measures it deems necessary, including, but not limited to: (a) requiring an immediate increase in security; (b) requiring compliance with applicable fire codes or other laws to ensure public safety and to maintain the integrity of the Premises; and (c) immediately ending the Activity. User shall pay all costs associated with such measures and shall forfeit their security deposit.
  6. **SERVICES, PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT.** User shall pay all costs associated with City staff used by User. If User desires to use City equipment and services City staff shall operate all equipment. User is not authorized to handle or operate such equipment unless permission has been authorized by City in writing. 

  8. **PROHIBITIONS.** User shall not, and shall not permit its officers, agents, employees, participants, patrons, occupants, vendors, contractors, guests and others, including assignees, to: (a) engage in any act that, to an ordinarily prudent person, would be reasonably foreseeable to cause harm to the Premises; (b) use or occupy the Premises or any part thereof for any unlawful, disreputable or ultra-hazardous use (including the prohibited or unauthorized use, storage or disposal of any Hazardous Substance as defined by U.C.A.. § 19-6-102 (2007)); (c) operate or conduct its Activity in the Premises in any manner that constitutes or gives rise to a nuisance of any kind; (d) bring any dangerous exhibits, materials, objects, vehicles or the like into the Premises; (e) make unauthorized use of Premises equipment; (f) improperly access areas outside of the specified use area; (g) engage in vandalism or other criminal activity; or (h) engage in any other action detrimental to the Premises or the City. User shall be liable for all damages associated with failure to comply with any provision under this section.



**ST. GEORGE CITY, UTAH**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 2023-03-003**

**A TEMPORARY REGULATION SUSPENDING THE PERMITTING OR PROCESSING  
OF CERTAIN SPECIAL EVENT PERMITS UNDER TITLE 3, CHAPTER 10 OF THE  
CITY CODE.**

**PREAMBLE**

**WHEREAS** Utah Code §10-3-702 grants to cities the legislative power to regulate and prohibit any activity, business, conduct, or condition authorized by the Utah Municipal Code which may be necessary to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the community; and

**WHEREAS** under that legislative authority, the City has previously enacted an Ordinance governing the use of public facilities and permitting of special events at those facilities as found in Title 3, Chapter 10 of the City Code; and

**WHEREAS** the City of St. George (“City”) has determined that the use of public facilities for special events has increased in recent years to the point that maintenance of the facilities is becoming more difficult; and

**WHEREAS** the City believes that the public facilities should be available to the public and should not be over encumbered by scheduled special events; and

**WHEREAS** the City also believes that special events are of benefit to the City and create a sense of community, promote economic development, and provide entertainment opportunities for the citizens; and

**WHEREAS** the City desires to balance the use of the facilities by the public with the demand for the facilities by special events; and

**WHEREAS** the City is seeking to understand the impacts to the community from the amount and types of use of its public facilities, including to residents surrounding the public facilities from the increased traffic, road closures, and noise; and

**WHEREAS** the City also is also seeking to understand the type and quantity of City resources expended for special events at its public facilities; and

**WHEREAS** in order to properly study the issues, this temporary suspension shall be applicable to events at City owned facilities and not events held at private venues; and

**WHEREAS** under the legislative authority granted by to the City, the City believes that a temporary suspension or moratorium on new special event applications is necessary in order to effectively create new provisions which will better balance the needs of the City, the public, and the events; and

**WHEREAS** consistent with temporary land use regulations under Utah Code §10-9a-504, this temporary regulation would be in effect for no longer than six months from the effective date, thus allowing adequate time for the City to enact comprehensive regulations and standards regarding special events and the use of public facilities; and,

**WHEREAS** it is in the best interests of St. George City to provide for temporary prohibitions of new applications for special events while comprehensive regulations designed to protect the health, welfare and public safety within the City are being studied, publicly vetted and adopted;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of St. George, State of Utah, hereby ordains as follows:

Based upon the facts as set forth in the Preamble hereto, the City Council finds that there exists a compelling, countervailing public interest to enact the following temporary regulations:

- 1.2 An application for any recurring or repeat event located on City owned property or within City facilities which was not held within the previous calendar year and is not on the list of reoccurring events provided to the City Council by City staff on September 2, 2022; and
- 1.3 An application for any recurring or repeat event located on City owned property or within City facilities for which there has been enforcement action taken or threatened.

**Section 2** Except as otherwise specified above, Reoccurring Events and Filming Permits as those terms are defined in City Code §3-10-2 shall not be subject to this ordinance.

**Section 3** This permit suspension shall not be considered a “denial” of an event permit for which an appeal may be made.

**Section 4** The definition of Special Event as contained in §3-10-2 of the City Code is hereby amended as follows:

SPECIAL EVENT: A temporary event of any of the following or a combination of the following acts:

A. Any athletic event, entertainment event, parade, carnival, circus, dance, musical event, rodeo event, fighting event, racing event, live shows, fairs, concerts, block parties, filming event, or outdoor sales event, whether held for profit, nonprofit or charitable purposes held on private or public property within the city.

B. Any organized assemblage at any public park, public square or other city property which gathers for a common purpose or event under the direction and control of a person or entity and which uses more services, amusement devices such as stages, inflatable devices or temporary structures, or equipment, whether provided by the city or a third party, than normally provided to groups which reserve park facilities or other city-owned facilities.

C. Events held at the following are not special events under this chapter:

1. A building that has a business located in it that has a current annual business license as an event business;



OF CERTAIN SPECIAL EVENT PERMITS UNDER TITLE 3, CHAPTER 10 OF THE  
CITY CODE.**

**PREAMBLE**

**WHEREAS** Utah Code §10-3-702 grants to cities the legislative power to regulate and prohibit any activity, business, conduct, or condition authorized by the Utah Municipal Code which may be necessary to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the community; and

**WHEREAS** under that legislative authority, the City of St. George (“City”) has previously enacted on March 16, 2023, Ordinance No. 2023-03-003 temporarily restricting the use of public facilities and permitting of special events at those facilities; and

**WHEREAS** the City has determined additional amendments to the temporary regulation are necessary in order to properly execute the ordinance and existing City Code; and

**WHEREAS** it is in the best interests of St. George City to provide for temporary prohibitions of new applications for special events while comprehensive regulations designed to protect the health, welfare and public safety within the City are being studied, publicly vetted and adopted;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of St. George, State of Utah, hereby ordains as follows:

Based upon the facts as set forth in the Preamble hereto, the City Council finds that there exists a compelling, countervailing public interest to enact the following temporary regulations:

**Section 1** The provisions of City Code §3-10-1 through §3-10-10 are hereby suspended and made inapplicable for the following Special Event requests and no application shall be processed which is inconsistent with this suspension.

- 1.1 An application for any new Special Event located on City owned property or within City facilities which has not previously been held within the City of St. George excluding those events for which a completed application was received by the City by close of business March 15, 2023;
- 1.2 An application for any recurring or repeat event located on City owned property or within City facilities which was not held within the previous calendar year and is not on the list of reoccurring events provided to the City Council by City staff on March 21, 2023; and

- 1.3 An application for any recurring or repeat event located on City owned property or within City facilities for which there has been enforcement action taken or threatened.

**Section 2** Except as otherwise specified above, Reoccurring Events and Filming Permits as those terms are defined in City Code §3-10-2 shall not be subject to this ordinance.

**Section 3** This permit suspension shall not be considered a “denial” of an event permit for which an appeal may be made.

**Section 4** The definition of Special Event as contained in §3-10-2 of the City Code is hereby amended as follows:

SPECIAL EVENT: A temporary event of any of the following or a combination of the following acts:

A. Any athletic event, entertainment event, parade, carnival, circus, dance, musical event, rodeo event, fighting event, racing event, live shows, fairs, concerts, block parties, filming event, or outdoor sales event, whether held for profit, nonprofit or charitable purposes held on private or public property within the city.

B. Any organized assemblage at any public park, public square or other city property which gathers for a common purpose or event under the direction and control of a person or entity and which uses more services, amusement devices such as stages, inflatable devices or temporary structures, or equipment, whether provided by the city or a third party, than normally provided to groups which reserve park facilities or other city-owned facilities.

C. Events held at the following are not special events under this chapter:

1. A building that has a business located in it that has a current annual business license as an event business;

2. A building with an assembly group classification under the International Building Code, as adopted by the city, so long as the event does not exceed the posted occupant load as approved by the city and has a current annual business license, if required. ~~;~~ ~~and~~

~~3. A government owned facility.~~

D. For purposes of this chapter, ~~city~~ events organized and conducted by the City located on City owned property or within City facilities are not special events;



however, events held by non-city entities which may have some level of sponsored sponsorship by the city are special events.

**Section 5** The provisions of City Code §3-10-3 are hereby modified as follows:

It is unlawful for any No person, corporation, partnership, association, or other entity, public or private, shall to promote, advertise, or hold a special event without first obtaining a special event permit. Events which are listed on the March 21, 2023 list of reoccurring events and events for which the City is a sponsor may promote and advertise the event after submission of a preliminary application, confirmation by City staff of the availability of the location and dates for the event, and payment of the application fee, if any.

**Section 6** The provisions of City Code §3-10-4(C) are hereby modified as follows:

C. Advertising: No advertising of a special event shall be permitted until city approval of the special event is granted and a special event permit is issued. Events which are listed on the March 21, 2023 list of reoccurring events and events for which the City is a sponsor may promote and advertise the event after submission of a preliminary application, confirmation by City staff of the availability of the location and dates for the event, and payment of the application fee, if any

**Section 7** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication and/or posting as required by law and shall thereafter be effective until September 16, 2023.





1. I am competent to testify and have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit. If called to testify as to the truth of the matters stated herein, I could and would competently do so.
2. I am now and, at all times relevant, have been the St. George City (City) Recorder.
3. My duties include receiving, reviewing, and responding to Utah's Government Records Access and Management Act (GRAMA) requests for public records held by City.
4. I am also responsible for preparing and posting City Council agendas, making and keeping audio recordings of public meetings, which may be regular city council meetings or work meetings, and preparing the corresponding meeting minutes.
5. The City received a GRAMA request from Plaintiff Mitski Avalox and the City responded on or about April 19, 2023 with 88 pages of public records consisting of emails, texts, or social media posts of one or more members of the City Council or Staff.
6. The City received an additional GRAMA request from Ms. Avalox and the City responded on or about May 30, 2023 with 797 pages of public records consisting of emails, texts, or social media posts of one or members of the City Council or Staff.  
The City provided Ms. Avalox with an approximate total of 885 public records.

7. The City Council publicly discussed the challenges the City was facing regarding special events and the over usage of the parks, including wear and tear on the property and grass, requests and approval process for city sponsorship or fee waiver, the City Code's advertising prohibition and 45-day application rule requirement, and/or city events/city sponsored events/reoccurring events, at one or more regular city council or work meeting on the following dates:

1. June 23, 2022 Work Meeting; Discussion Regarding Sponsorship of The Downtown Farmers Market. Discussion on where to locate the market; concerns raised on closing city street, city sponsorship; the issues with moving the market to Vernon Worthen Park. 2. July 14, 2022 Work Meeting; Discussion Regarding the Process for Special Events and Potential Tiers for Insurance Certificates. 



5. Soon thereafter it was brought to my attention that some recurring events were not on the spreadsheet. It appeared that the spreadsheet had not been updated by my predecessor before leaving city employment. As a new employee myself, I met with a previous special events coordinator (and now executive assistant to the Mayor and City Manager) Emilie Pinkleman to review and update the spreadsheet.
6. On or about March 21, 2023, I helped prepare the finalized Recurring special event spreadsheet with Ms. Pinkleman and it was emailed to Marc Mortensen the same day.
7. On or about March 21, 2023 Marc Mortensen emailed the Recurring events and sponsorship/fee waivers & fee schedule to the City Council with included additional tabs and a summary page.

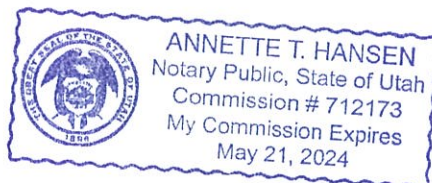





The advertising provision, 3-10-4(C), was enacted on October 1, 2015 (Ord. 2015-10-003). It was then amended on December 15, 2022 (amd. Ord. 2022-12-006), and it was amended again on April 6, 2023 (Ord. 2023-04-001).

St. George City can find no evidence or record of the provision being enforced prior to March 31, 2023.

### 2. List all events identified on the March 21, 2023 list.

Please see Exhibit 1.

### 3. List all event applications denied based on the advertising prohibition or approved in spite of the advertising prohibition. Identify each event and list the application date, applicant, date of denial or approval. Supporting documentation for this answer shall include the applications, any documentation of decision, notes of meetings, and email or message chains discussing these applications or the decisions.

No events that violated the advertising provision were approved. The list created by Jocelyn Chavez showed 13 web captures of advertising (DSTARS 58-59) and listed 4 upcoming events as having no advertising on the internet. Of the 13 web captures, 6 did not violate the provisions because they were recurring events on the March 21, 2023 list or city sponsored events (shown below). One event had already occurred prior to the Council directive to enforce all provisions of the code, one event was not considered a “special event” requiring a permit and an encroachment permit to close the road was issued, and one web capture was an agenda item for a conference and not considered advertising. Four web captures (two for Southern Utah Drag Stars’ event and one each for the two others) were new events which violated the advertising provisions. The four events which did not advertise are also shown below.
