**ORDER RE JOINT STIPULATION
REGARDING BRIEFING SCHEDULE FOR
PARTIES' MOTIONS FOR SUMMARY
JUDGMENT**

The Court has reviewed the Parties' Joint Stipulation Regarding Briefing Schedule for Parties' Motions for Summary Judgment, and for good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED granting the Joint Stipulation and adopting the Parties' stipulated briefing schedule for summary judgment motions directed only to the merits of Plaintiffs' constitutional claims.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

- 1) The Parties shall file cross-motions for summary judgment directed only to the merits of Plaintiffs' constitutional claims on or before November 17, 2023.
- 2) The Parties shall file their opposition briefs to the cross-motions for summary judgment directed only to the merits of Plaintiffs' constitutional claims on or

1 before December 20, 2023.

2 3) The Parties shall file replies in support of their cross-motions for summary
3 judgment directed only to the merits of Plaintiffs' constitutional claims on or
4 before January 12, 2024.


5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Parties' motions for summary judgment
6 directed to the merits of Plaintiffs' constitutional claims including their supporting
7 memoranda, and the responses in opposition to those motions including their supporting
8 memoranda, may not exceed twenty-two (22) pages, exclusive of attachments and any
9 required statement of facts and that the Parties' replies in support of summary judgment
10 including their supporting memoranda may not exceed sixteen (16) pages, exclusive of
11 attachments.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Parties shall file a joint stipulated briefing
13 schedule for addressing an appropriate remedy within 30 days of the entry of an order
14 granting any of Plaintiffs' requests for declaratory relief.

15 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
