**ORDER**

Before the Court is Mark Marvin’s Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus in which Mr. Marvin seeks habeas corpus relief because “the children petitioners are trapped in a de facto imprisonment,” and they need protection from “Frankenstein medical doctors.” (Doc. 137 at 1.) A brief review of the record indicates that Mr. Marvin is neither a party nor counsel for one of the parties in this matter, and his Petition is neither appropriate nor well taken.
