ORDER

Defendants have filed a Motion for an Enlargement of Time (“Motion”) seeking to extend the time in which to file their opposition to plaintiff, pro se, Nick Harrison’s Motion to Clarify and Enforce the Court’s previous orders in this civil action. [Dkt. No. 391]. Defendants seek a three week extension of time in which to file their opposition memorandum and to continue the hearing scheduled for Friday, July 14, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. to a later, unspecified date. Although the Motion establishes good cause to grant a modest extension to defendants’ time to file an opposition memorandum, it does not establish good cause for the lengthy extension requested or to continue the July 14 hearing. For these reasons, the Motion is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that the defendants file their opposition memorandum by Friday, July 7, 2023, and plaintiff file his reply memorandum before noon on Thursday, July 13, 2023.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel of record, and plaintiff, pro se.
