2019 (Doc. 14), Defendants Warden True, John Does 1-10, Deborah Schult, and Donald Trump  
were **DISMISSED without prejudice** as to Counts 1, 3, 4, and 6.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that, pursuant to the Court's Order  
of July 25, 2019 (Doc. 14), Defendants Warden True, John Does 1-10, Deborah Schult, and  
Donald Trump were **DISMISSED with prejudice** as to Counts 2 and 5.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that, pursuant to the filing of the  
Amended Complaint (Doc. 106) on April 30, 2021, Defendants Director of the Federal Bureau  
of Prisons, L.J.W. Hollingsworth, and J. Doe were **DISMISSED without prejudice**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that, pursuant to the Stipulation of Dismissal filed on December 12, 2023 (Doc. 323) and the Court's Order of December 13, 2023 (Doc. 324), this entire action is **DISMISSED with prejudice** pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) with each party to bear its own costs and fees.
