



- 3) The motions filed by Defendants W.G. and L.D. to dismiss Plaintiffs' amended complaint are **GRANTED without prejudice**. (Docs. 29, 35.)
- 4) In summation, Count I is **DISMISSED** insofar as it is brought against Defendant Officer Greenly, Count V is **DISMISSED** insofar as it is brought against Defendants T.F, L.D. and W.G., Count VI is **DISMISSED** insofar as it is brought against Defendants W.G. and L.D., and Count VII is **DISMISSED** insofar as it is brought against Defendants W.G. and L.D. The dismissals are all without prejudice except for the dismissal of the sole claim against Officer Greenly.
- 5) Absent the potential filing of a second amended complaint, the claims surviving in this action are Count I insofar as it is brought against Defendant Hoffman; Count II; Count III; Count IV; Count V insofar as it is brought against Defendants D.M., C.H., and C.A.; Count VI insofar as it is brought against Defendants T.F., D.M., C.H., and C.A.; and Count VII insofar as it is brought against Defendants T.F., D.M., C.H., and C.A.
- 6) Plaintiffs may file an amended complaint within 21 days of this order.
